STATE TEAM DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES

Position Title: Head Coach

Purpose of Position:

To prepare the team physically and mentally for National Competition.

Authority:

The Head Coach has complete authority over the team's performance and actions at all times. This includes both on and off-ice activities and programs.

Duties:

1. Will have input and authority on the selection and appointment of the assistant coach(s) as approved by IHWA and to assign duties required of the assistant coaches for the betterment of the team.
2. Design and submit to the Team Manager, a pre- selection program outlining in detail the criteria by which players will be selected.
3. Will have input and provide suggestions and recommendations on all activities affecting the team.
4. Will be in control of the team's players and assistants from the time of departure from WA to the conclusion of the Nationals.
5. Ensure all players and assistants follow all directives and protocol as defined by the Team Manager.
6. Manage and be the liaison on any matters concerning a player, assistant or the team, and report these matters and /or issues to the Team Manager.
7. Has the authority to allocate tasks to players who are not competing or are injured .Tasks allocated to injured players are to be consulted with and approved by the team's Medical Officer or Doctor.
8. On completion of the Championship, prepare and submit a report covering the team's performance and include any recommendations for improvement to the Team Manager no less than 30 days after the completion of the trip.
